Dry fixing

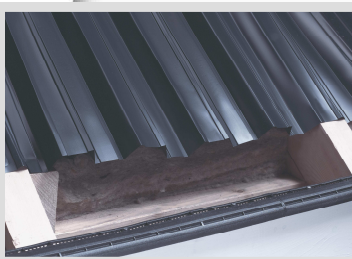

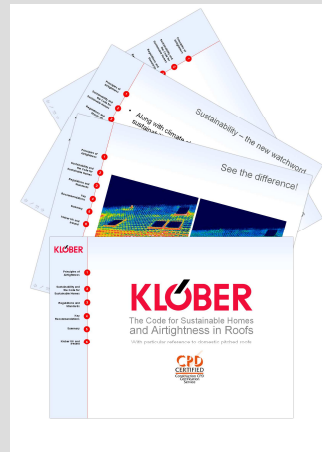


CPD Presentations
